Report of the Industrial Visit

Sonhira Sugar Factory, Wangi and Sagareshwar Spinning Mills, Kadegaon
[Saturday, 20th January, 2018]

Field work is very important and effective learning method. Law College students are required to visit various Institutions where law is applied. It made mandatory by the BCI under the heading of Internship Work. As a part of Internship work, and also to get knowledge about Industrial and Labour Law, Companies Act, Co-op. sector, the College has organized a tour to Sonhira Co-op. Sugar Factory, Wangi and Sagareshwar Co-op. Spinning Mills, Kadegaon on Saturday, 20th January, 2018.

The journey to the tour started at 8.00 a.m. from the College premises. First of all we visited Chouranginath Temple which is situated on the hill near Sonsal. All had their tea and breakfast and proceed for the Sonhira Sugar Factory, Wangi.



We reached factory gate around 10.30 O'clock, after initial formalities, a security of the factory took us to the concerned authority. He showed all the manufacturing process of making of sugar from sugarcane (i.e. raw material to finished product). They also showed us the warehouses where all the bags of sugar are stored. Thereafter, we reached at 22 mega watt co-generation power project in the same campus. The Project manager showed the whole technology and machines like boilers, turbines, Switch yard, pipes, etc. and guided us the process of generation of power from the factory waste of the sugarcane. The information and knowledge we got there is helpful from the point view of environmental issues, like waste management, reuse and recycle process, etc. Thereafter, they took us in the administrative office guest room. We met the Factory Chairperson Hon. Shri. Mohanrao (Dada) Kadam. He welcomes us and make arrangements of the hospitality of all students and faculty. Mr. Arun Jadhav, Labour Officer felicitated our Principal and two faculties. He also guides us about the labour and human resource management in the factory. He discussed about the health, Safety and Welfare measures adopted by the factory for their workers, record and registers maintained by factory, etc. The Honorable Chairman also offered us sugar juice.





The Sugar factory visit continued for two and half an hour. At 2.00 pm we had our lunch in the garden of factory. After finishing lunch, we travelled to Sagareshwar Spinning Mill situated in Kadegaon. We saw the whole manufacturing process of converting raw cotton into spinning threads. The Spinning Mill is well equipped with the advance and new technology. All moved all departments saw the process. We met the number of labour working there asked about the importance of every process. Then we went to the Quality Control Division where, they gave us very important information about the maintenance of quality of the products. Thereafter, the management offered us breakfast with tea in the canteen of the Mill. Thereafter, we visited the Chairman of the Spinning Mill, Honorable Shri Shantaram (Bapu) Kadam. He welcomed and praised all of us for visiting the Mill.





After visiting to the Sagareshwar Spinning Mill, Kadegao, in the evening, nearly at 5.30 p.m., we visited sightseeing the Dongari Devi Temple nearby the Mill in Kadegaon. All students and staff enjoyed and took darshan of Dongarai Devi on top of the hill.

At last nearly around 6.00 p.m., we attended the Valedictory & Prize Distribution Function of Bharatiyam – Kala Mahotsav held at Kadegaon. We also seen and enjoy some of the performances which were awarded with the prizes. At 7.00 p.m., we moved for coming back to the college. We came back at 8.00 p.m. in the College.

In this Industrial visit, nearly 42 students and 3 faculties took part and benefited. This Industrial Visit organized by the College on the Self finance basis. With this activity, the students and staff enjoyed the visit with multi-dimension purposes of Study tour, Sightseeing and participating in the Cultural Programme. In this way, a memorial activity is being held on behalf of the College. Dr. P. B. Chavate, I/c Principal, participated as the chief guide to the students and staff.
