4. Make sure that your essay contains an *argument*. That gives a strong voice to the essay. Your arguments are backed and strengthened by the sources you cite.
5. *Cite properly*. Sources from the internet should not make all of your citations. Books are still wonderful and scholarly.
6. *Check again* for any errors in spellings, grammar, sentence construction etc.
7. Most crucial part of the law essay writing process is that the information must be taken from relevant, reliable and up to date sources.

#### Body of Legal Essay

##### 1. Introduction

Your introduction must be concise. Firstly, outline the research topic with an impressive introduction. Do this without simply repeating the given question.

## 2. Road map /Contents

Secondly, create a road map for the reader, letting them know how the essay will approach the question. This shall contain the object, purpose of topic, Significance, historical development, legislative and judicial developments in the area. Road map shall be flawless and continuous.

## 3. Main Body

The main body of the essay is where you will go into detail. Briefly mention all of the main points that you have made throughout.

## 4. Divide main body in to sub-parts

Making Sub-parts is essential to understand the topic. Do make sub-parts as per the need.

## 5. Concluding remarks

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## **Policy statement for Dissertation**

### **Guidelines for LL.M. Dissertation**

### **Guidelines for Research Supervisors/Teachers**

1. Students shall be sensitized towards the object of the dissertation and research work.
2. Teacher shall allot the topic individually to each student and frame the title so as to research design shall be clearly understood.
3. Students shall be well aware about the research methodology, framing of hypotheses, chapterization, testing of hypothesis, citations and acknowledgment of sources, etc.
4. There shall be uniformity in design of cover page, header, footer, page numbering, font and font size, citation method, etc. Preferably this shall be provided by the Research Supervisor.
5. Dissertation is miniature of Ph.D. thesis, it shall receive same respect and protocol.
6. Allot the topic at least 90 days before the date of final submission.
7. Topic of research shall be innovative, novel, contemporary and probably inter-disciplinary in nature and non-doctrinal.
8. Sample selection shall be careful and sufficient. Meagre sampling and data collection leads to absurdity and in vain.
9. Ask student to meet at least 3-4 times with monthly progress report.
10. Late and idle submission shall be outrightly rejected.

## **Guidelines for Students**

1. Student shall devote and dedicate sincerely towards the process of dissertation. It is the lifetime work of academic endeavor.
2. It is expected to understand and reflect upon the research problem, research design, hypothesis, chapterization, citation methods, etc.
3. Topic shall be chosen well in advance, at least 90 days before the date of final submission.
4. Student shall submit monthly progress report of the research work. Meet your research supervisor at least 4-5 times to discuss about the topic, framing of title, research method, data collection, and for allied process.
5. At least Three Progress Report (one progress report per month) shall be submitted without fail, signed by Student, Research Supervisor and HoD/Principal.
6. Failure to the submission of progress report in time Fine Rs.100/- (per progress report) shall be charged. Submission of progress report shall be allowed to submit subject to approval of HoD/Principal.
7. Dissertation – Font- Times New Roman- size 14, Line Spacing 1.5, Margin- 1.5” from Left and 1” from other sides, Foot noting- Time New roman size -10, Header- “LL.M. Dissertation- BVYCLC Karad, AY ....., Footer – Title of dissertation and page number
8. Get your rough draft checked before final submission. Report of Anti-plagiarism check is mandatory at the time of submission of dissertation. Similarity allowed 30% Online, 20% offline.
9. Dissertation shall be submitted in black hard bound with golden embossing in two sets signed by research supervisor, principal/HoD.
10. Dissertation shall be of minimum of 125 pages excluding front pages like 1. Cover Page, 2. Certificate of Supervisor forwarded by Principal, 3. Acknowledgement, 4. Index, 5. Case laws, 6. Abbreviations, etc.
11. Dissertation shall be submitted in 2 sets (one For College and one for student) in black hard bound with golden embossing.
12. Timely submission is mandatory and research supervisor shall have final decision with regard to the submission of dissertation.
13. Dissertation shall be considered as serious, honest and fruitful activity of the academic endeavor.

**during the entire period of legal studies** under NGO, Trial and Appellate Advocates, Judiciary, Legal Regulatory authorities, Legislatures and Parliament, Other Legal Functionaries, Market Institutions, Law Firms, Companies, Local Self Government and other such bodies as the University shall stipulate, where law is practiced either in action or in dispute resolution or in management.

Provided that internship in any year cannot be for a continuous period of more than Four Weeks and **all students shall** at least gone through once in the entire academic period with Trial and Appellate Advocates.

(b) **Each student shall keep Internship diary** in such form as may be stipulated by the University concerned and the same shall be evaluated by the Guide in Internship and also a Core Faculty member of the staff each time.

The total mark shall be assessed in the Final Semester of the course in the 4th Clinical course as stipulated under the Rules in Schedule II.
